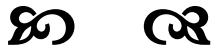

He currently studies with John Kadz and Johanne Perron at the Mount Royal Conservatory, while pursuing a degree in composition at the University of Calgary. Since moving to Alberta for his studies, Andrew has had the chance of working with internationally renowned artists like Amanda Forysth, Andres Diaz, and Colin Carr.
