Born to a family of musicians and teachers in Toronto, Ontario, Andrew Park has been surrounded by music all his life. He currently studies with John Kadz and Johanne Perron at the Mount Royal Conservatory, while pursuing a degree in composition at the University of Calgary. Since moving to Alberta for his studies, Andrew has had the chance of working with internationally renowned artists like Amanda Forysth, Andres Diaz, and Colin Carr.



Outside of his successes in the classical genre, which include: performing as a soloist accompanied by orchestra in New York; Toronto; and, most recently with the Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra in Alberta, he has written and recorded new music with artists across Canada and in Europe.
